



Does the center provide snacks and/or lunches?

St. Maurice Daycare is currently not serving snacks or lunches due to COVID-19.

What happens if I'm late picking up my child?

After 6:00pm a late fee of \$10.00 for the 1st 10 minutes or under per child will be charged. \$5.00 for every 5 minutes or under per child thereafter.

Does my child have to nap?

No, your child will only nap if it is developmentally appropriate for them. Some children may rest on a mat for a maximum of ½ hour

Does my child have to go outside if they're sick?

As per our policy, if your child is too sick to go outside they are too sick to be at daycare.

When can my child return after being sick?

Your child may return to the daycare once they are symptom free for 36hrs.

Do I have to pay for days my child does not attend?

Yes, you must pay the daycare for all days - regardless of attendance.

Does the center have different hours for holidays?

St. Maurice Daycare closes for all Statutory Holidays and the Annual PD conference. We also close early at 1:00 p.m. Christmas Eve and 4:00 p.m. New Year's eve.

Do I have to participate in the fundraising?

With everyone's busy schedule, we do not require parents to fundraise. We do appreciate a \$5.00 donation per child per pay period in lieu of fundraising. This donation is directly related to the guest visitors and special events hosted by the daycare.

How much does daycare cost?

St. Maurice offers the following programs
Under 2 years old - \$10.00 a day
2 - 5 years old - \$10.00 a day
6-12 years
Before and After School - \$8.60
Inservice- \$20.80

When are my fees due?

Fees are due at the beginning of each pay period. We accept automatic withdrawal, debit payments and cheques.

Who should I talk to about my bill?

You should talk to the office of the daycare. Our employees do not deal with parent payments.

Does my child have to play outside when it's cold?

Yes, we play outside every day, sometimes twice! With the exception of cold weather (- 24 including wind chill is the Provincial regulation)
